ENTRIES

- Must be taken locally and convey a sense of the people, places, and happenings that make up our great and diverse community.
- Must be no larger than 11" x 14".
- Must be matted (no more than 2" per side).
- Can be of any photographic medium (black/white, color, digital, manipulated, etc.).
- Must be suitable for public display and community viewing.

PLEASE ALSO NOTE

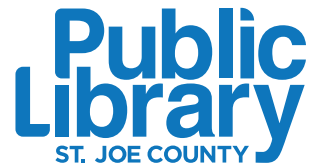
- Entry form must be attached to the back of each photo submitted.
- Only one photograph per entry form, however individuals may submit up to three entries.
- The Library cannot accept framed photographs.
