Answer Key - Trivia

How much do you know about sharks and other ocean creatures? Take the quiz below to find out! (Check your answers at sjcpl.org/summer-reading)

1. What is the largest fish in the world?

- Blue whale
- Whale shark
- Great white shark

Blue whales are larger than whale sharks, but they are mammals, not fish!

2. What creature lives on every continent except Antarctica?

- Otter
- Seal
- Turtle

Seals live on every continent, including Antarctica; Otters live everywhere except Australia and Antarctica.

3. How many hearts does an octopus have?

- One heart
- Two hearts
- Three hearts

Two of the hearts pump blood past the gills to pick up oxygen, and the third one circulates the blood around the body.

4. Which sea creature sleeps with one eye open?

- Dolphin
- Starfish
- Seahorse

Seahorses sleep with both eyes open. Starfish have eyes, but they don't sleep!

5. Do sharks have bones?

- Yes
- No

They have cartilage!

6. What creature makes the loudest sound of any animal on the planet?

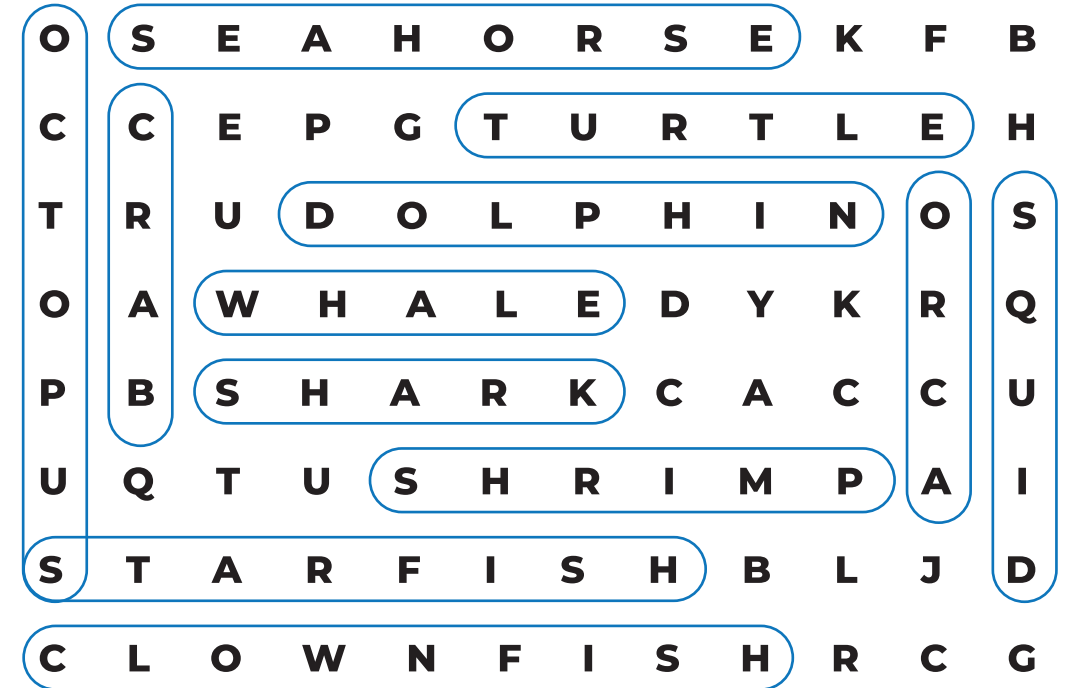
- Walrus

- Blue whale

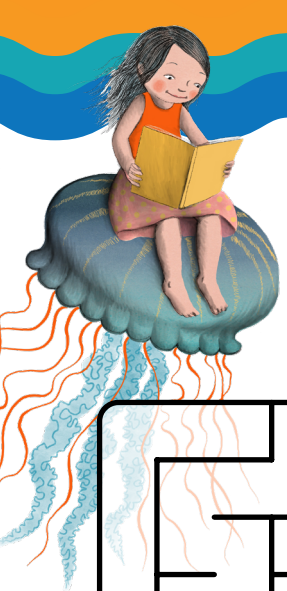
The blue whale's call can reach 180 decibels – as loud as a jet plane!

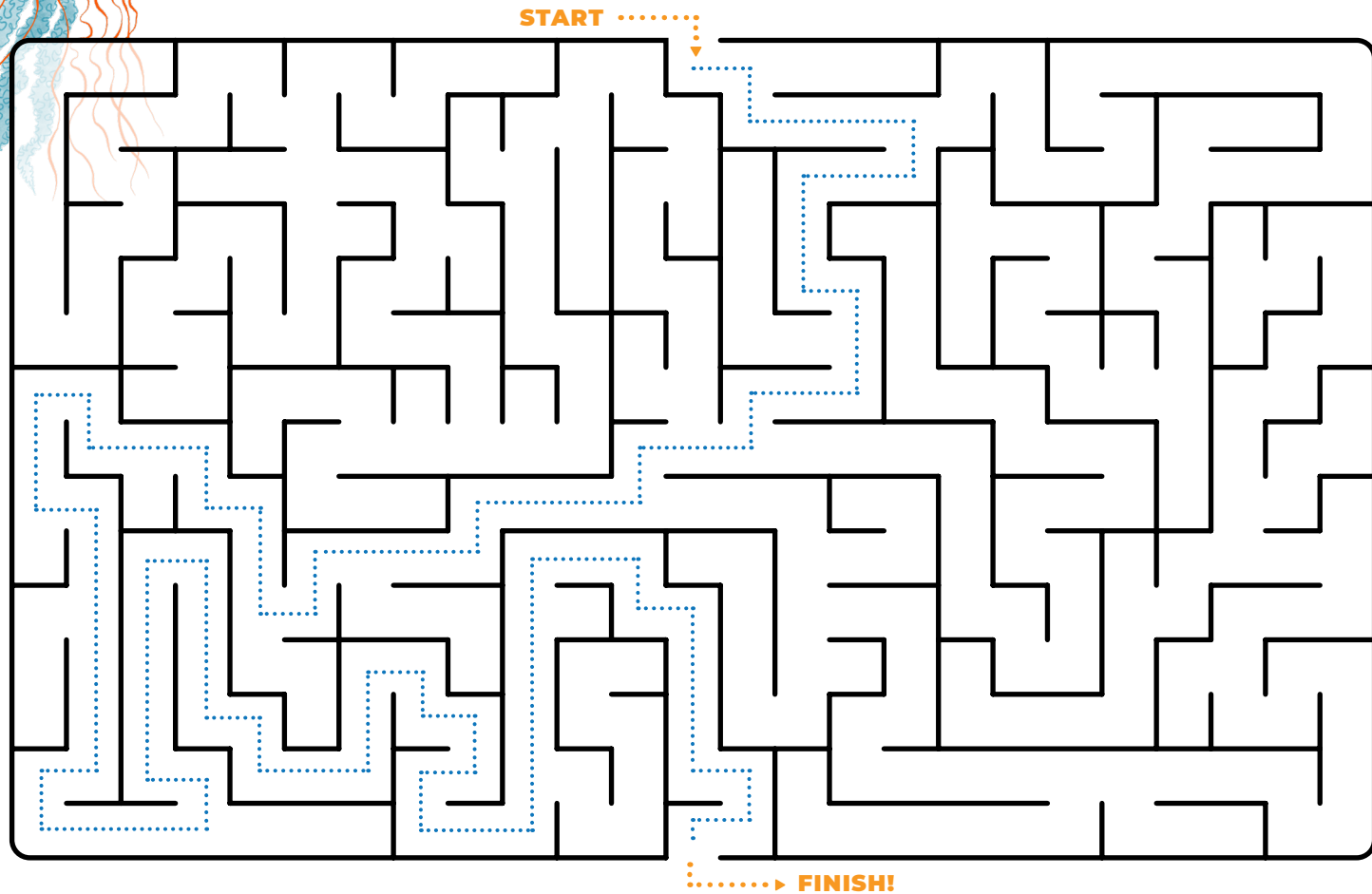
