Snap Peas Sugar Ann

Plant April/May in full or partial sun at a depth of 1/2" - 1" with a distance of 18" - 36" between plants.



Rangitoto Spinach

Plant early spring in partial or shade at a depth of 1/2" - 1" with a distance of 12" - 18" between rows.



Lettuce All Star Gourmet Mix

Plant early spring in partial or shade at a depth of 1/2" - 1" with a distance of 12" - 18" between rows.



Cucumber Marketmore Organic

Plant May/June in full, partial or shade at a depth of 1/2" with a distance of 24" - 36" between plants.



New Girl Tomato

Plant late May/June in full sun or partial shade at a depth of 1/2" - 1" with a distance of 24" - 36" between rows.



Green Beans Provider

Plant early spring to mid-summer in full, partial or shade at a depth of 1" with a distance of 20" - 36" between plants.



Genovese Basil Organic

Plant indoors late April then transplant May/June in full sun at a depth of 1/4" - 1/2" with a distance of 18" between plants.



Catnip Herb

Plant between May and September in full sun at a depth of 1/8" - 1/4" with a distance of 12" - 18" between plants.



Giant of Italy Parsley

Plant May in full sun at a depth of 1/4" - 1/2" with a distance of 12" - 18" between plants.



Royal Hybrid Sunflower

Plant June in full sun or partial shade at a depth of 1" - 1 1/2" with a distance of 8" - 12" between plants.



Black-Eyed Susan*

Plant May/June in full or partial sun at a depth of 1" with a distance of 10" - 12" between plants.



Purple Coneflower*

Plant May/June in full or partial sun at a depth of 1" with a distance of 18" - 24" between plants.



Wild Bergamot*

Plant May/June in full or partial sun at a depth of 1/2" - 1" with a distance of 18" - 24" between plants.



Racer Pumpkin


Plant May/June in full sun or partial shade at a depth of 1/2" - 1" two seeds per hole with a distance of 3 - 5 feet between plants.



Sugar Baby Watermelon

Plant May/June in full sun or partial shade at a depth of 1/2" - 1" two seeds per hole with a distance of 3 - 5 feet between plants.

***Stratification** is a process of treating seeds to simulate natural conditions that the seeds must experience before germination can occur. For best success, you can either sow the seeds directly in the garden in late fall or start them indoors 8-10 weeks before the last expected spring frost.
